



FUDCon Kuala Lumpur 2012  
Guide Book





## Welcome to Kuala Lumpur (KL).

Upon touchdown, now you are at the Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA). This directions will bring you to the venue which would be University College of Technology and Innovation (UCTI), in Technology Park Malaysia, Bukit Jalil.

You will take two trains route to venue which are:

### KLIA Transit (purple line)

KLIA Transit is similar like KLIA Express, only that it will stop at three transit station before reach its final destination which is KL Sentral (KL Transportation Hub)

### LRT Sri Petaling (brown line)

Light Transit Rail (LRT) Sri Petaling is a fast commuter train with interval of 5-10 minutes for each trip. This LRT connect Sentul Timur and Sri Petaling. This route is the split of the LRT Ampang where the route split at Chan Sow Lin LRT Station. Be sure you take the right train whenever you take LRT (Ampang/Sri Petaling)

First, take KLIA Transit to Bandar Tasik Selatan (BTS) Station. The fare is exactly 26.50 MYR (per one-way trip). The Ticket Counter available at Arrival Concourse (Level 3) and Train Track (Level 1)

The first trip from KLIA would be at 0552 and the last trip would be at 0103. Do remind that there is no service at 0022 and 0052.

The first trip from BTS is at 0433 and the last trip would be at 0010.

The first trip from KL Sentral is at 0433 and the last trip would be at 0003.

The journey will take time in less than 35 minutes. Upon arrival at the BTS KLIA Transit Station, disembark and walk a little bit to the LRT Station (under the same hub) and there will be only Sri Petaling LRT that passing here. So, you don't have to worry of taking wrong train.

Buy a ticket/token to Bukit Jalil. The fare would be 1.70 MYR (per one-way). You will arrived at Bukit Jalil on the second stop. Shuttle bus is provided from/to the LRT Station.

If you want to go to KL Sentral, its recommended to take KLIA Express instead of KLIA Transit. A non-stop route directly from KLIA - KL Sentral.

Here is the detail on the trip:

### KLIA Express

Fare: MYR 35.00 (one-way)

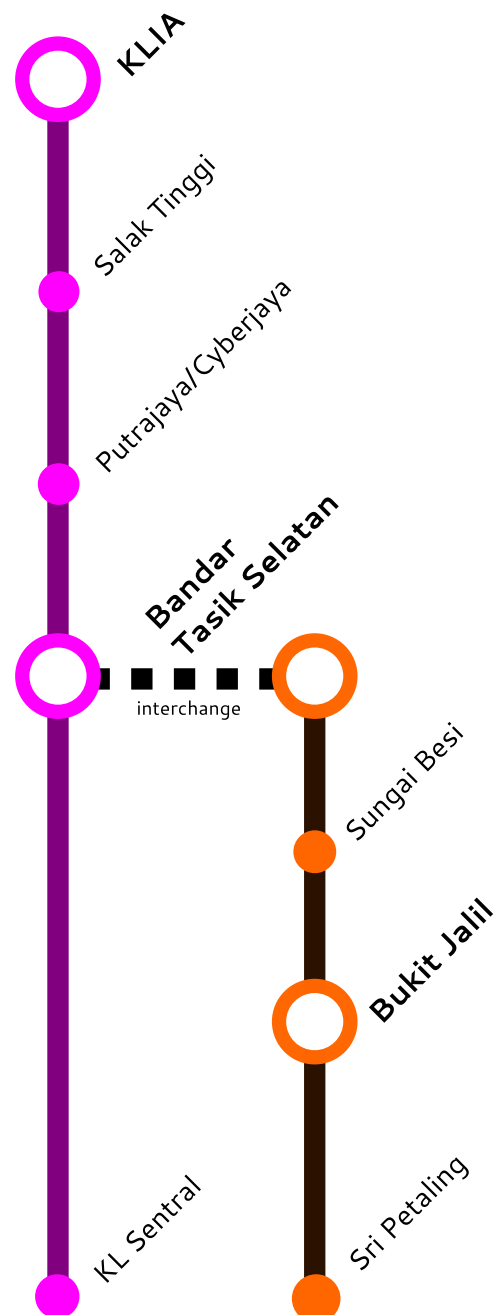
First/Last Trip: 0500 / 0100

Intervals: 15 mins (peak)

20 mins (off-peak)

Ticket is available at Main Terminal:

-Train Track (Level 1)



## Welcome to Kuala Lumpur (KL).

Upon touchdown, now you are at the Kuala Lumpur Low Cost Carrier Terminal Airport (LCCT). This directions will bring you to the venue which would be University College of Technology and Innovation (UCTI), in Technology Park Malaysia, Bukit Jalil.

You will take a shuttle bus and two trains route to venue which are:

### Shuttle Bus Services (black dotted line)

Shuttle Bus services is a bus facilities provided exclusively for LCCT passengers to commute from LCCT to the nearest KLIA Transit Salak Tinggi station.

### KLIA Transit (purple line)

KLIA Transit is similar like KLIA Express, only that it will stop at three transit station before reach its final destination which is KL Sentral (KL Transportation Hub)

### LRT Sri Petaling (brown line)

Light Transit Rail (LRT) Sri Petaling is a fast commuter train with interval of 5-10 minutes for each trip. This LRT connect Sentul Timur and Sri Petaling. This route is the split of the LRT Ampang where the route split at Chan Sow Lin LRT Station. Be sure you take the right train whenever you take LRT (Ampang/Sri Petaling)

First, buy a KLIA Transit ticket from LCCT to Bandar Tasik Selatan (BTS) Station. The fare is exactly 10.80 MYR (per one-way trip). The fare includes Shuttle Bus service (SkyBus/AeroBus) and KLIA Transit Train. Ticket counter is available at LCCT Domestic Arrival Hall or Ticketing Counter.

The Shuttle Bus departs from the Shuttle Service bay (opposite Domestic Arrival). It will directs you to the Salak Tinggi KLIA Transit Station. You will wait for a KLIA Transit train here.

The first trip from LCCT would be at 0720 and the last trip would be at 0003. Do remind that there is no service at 0022 and 0052.

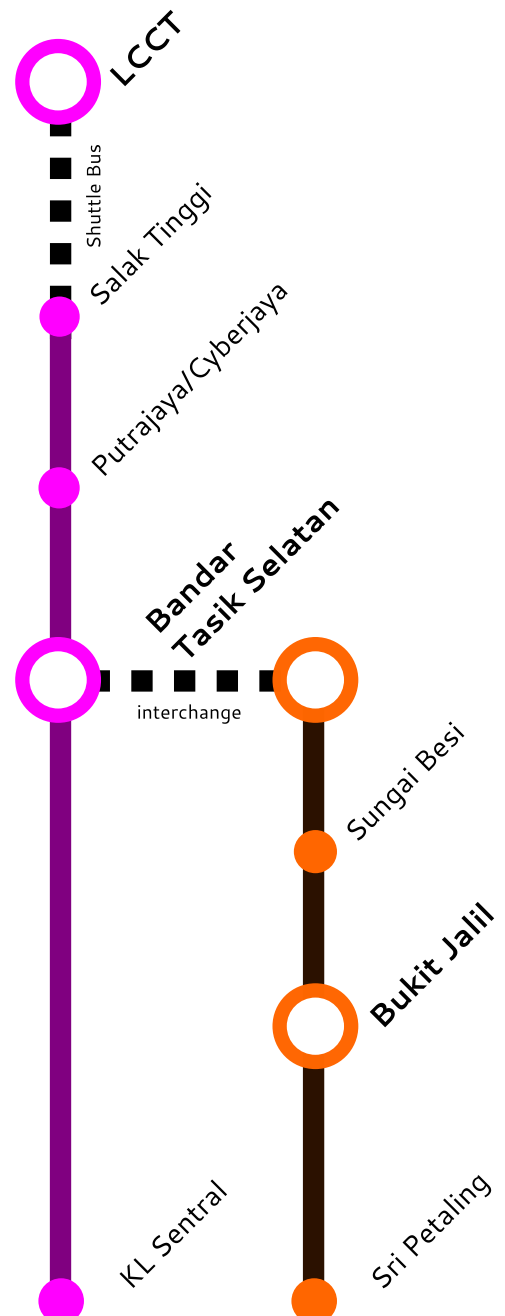
The first trip from BTS is at 0440 and the last trip would be at 0010.

The first trip from KL Sentral is at 0433 and the last trip would be at 0003.

The journey will take time in less than 60 minutes. Upon arrival at the BTS KLIA Transit Station, disembark and walk a little bit to the LRT Station (under the same hub) and there will be only Sri Petaling LRT that passing here. So, you don't have to worry of taking wrong train.

Buy a ticket/token to Bukit Jalil. The fare would be 1.70 MYR (per one-way). You will arrived at Bukit Jalil on the second stop. Shuttle bus is provided from/to the LRT Station.

If you want to go to KL Sentral, buy the ticket to KL Sentral. The fare is exactly 12.50 MYR (one-way) and this fare include Shuttle Bus (SkyBus/AeroBus) service and KLIA Transit train. Take note that you cannot access KLIA EXpress (non-stop express train between KLIA and KL Sentral) from LCCT.





There are several alternatives modes for transportation if you not preferring to hassle with the waiting time, memorizing all the routes and station or interchanging trains.

Since you are roaming around the Kuala Lumpur/Klang Valley districts, so the easiest way to reach the destination pinpoint is only by taking taxi. Kuala Lumpur City, Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA), Kuala Lumpur Low-Cost-Carrier Terminal (LCCT) and even Bukit Jalil, where University College of Technology and Innovation (UCTI) resides, are located within this metro area.

## TAXI

Taking taxi is quite straightforward in term of reaching destination.

Upon your arrival to either KLIA or LCCT, you can directly get a taxi from here. Your destination would be to this university as stated:

**University College of Technology and Innovation (UCTI)  
Technology Park Malaysia  
Bukit Jalil, 57000 Kuala Lumpur  
Malaysia**

## FARES

The fares from/to KLIA/LCCT to/from Bukit Jalil (UCTI) would be around 70 – 75 Malaysian Ringgit (MYR) for a budget taxi. If you prefer to have a Premier taxi, you can have it at a price of 150 MYR. A 50% surcharge is levied to passenger if you are taking taxi around midnight to 6AM.

## TRAVEL INFO

A journey from/to KLIA/LCCT to UCTI would take about a maximum 63 kilometers and less than 55 minutes drive.

Be sure to rent taxi from the authorized ticket provider. There will be counter to rent or inquiry on taxi services. You can go to the Airport's Information Counter for inquiries.

## WiFi

There are several places that providing you a free public WiFi. It's accessible around the airport, KL city, campus areas (UCTI), fast foods restaurants (i.e McDonalds), coffeehouse (i.e Starbucks, OldTown White Coffee) and even the Mamak's restaurants.

Mamak's restaurants is an Indian fusion-cuisine restaurant run by Indian-Muslim workers)

OldTown White Coffee is a Malaysian-Chinese local brand coffeehouse (we call it as Kopitiam)

You can also access the city WiFi provided by WirelessKL. This WiFi is accessible around the city's hotspot area like Technology Park Malaysia (UCTI is in here), Kuala Lumpur's Golden Triangle (covering KLCC, KL Sentral, Bukit Bintang, Bangsar) but they require you to Sign Up for free account first.

## MOBILE INTERNET

If you want to get a mobile internet services for your phone, you can buy a phone prepaid starter kit (which will provide you a local phone number and internet services). Prepaid Starter pack cost around 10 – 20 MYR.

There are three major Mobile Service Operators; Maxis, Celcom and Digi. Be sure that you are taking the prepaid services, NOT the postpaid one.

Listed here are the Mobile Internet services provided by this three operators:

### **Maxis** Prepaid Mobile Internet

- 1 Hour Pass [100Mb] – MYR 2
- 1 Day Pass [500Mb] – MYR 8
- 1 Week Pass [250Mb] – MYR 12

### **Celcom** Instanet (Broadband)

- Daily Pass [500Mb] – MYR 5
- Weekly Pass [ 1GB] – MYR 18

### **Digi** Prepaid Mobile Internet

- Daily Pass [100Mb] – MYR 3
- Weekly Pass [300Mb] – MYR 15

## **TIPS**

### **Electricity**

Malaysia use an electric voltage/frequency of 230V/50Hz and using a Type-G plug (British plug with three rectangular pins) It's strictly advised to bring your own Universal Plug Adaptor to avoid difficulties on your electrical appliances upon arrival.

### **Currency**

The currency exchange rate of 1 USD is about 3 MYR. It's not recommended to exchange your money at the airports or banks (if you not that urgent) as they provide a lower rates. You can check any licensed Money Changer kiosk in major shopping mall since they have a better rates. Be sure to say the amount you wish to exchange and ask for the 'best quote' as rates displayed on the board are often negotiable, especially for larger amounts.

Be sure you have at least 100 Malaysia Ringgit (MYR) for back-up since we don't accept other currencies. And the minimum cost from Airport to venue is around 35 MYR.
